## CLASSROOM MUSIC INSTRUCTION, GRADES 1-8-Ms. Schaffer

Grades 1-6 have music class twice every 7 days for 40 minutes.
Grades 7 and 8 have music class once every 7 days for 40 minutes.
Classroom music instruction includes active and creative music making for all students. This approach builds musicianship through singing, playing instruments, rhythm, and movement.

## CHRISTMAS WORSHIP SERVICES AND SPRING MUSICAL- Ms. Schaffer

Grades 1-8 participate in school wide musical presentations to develop, collaborate, and refine their music performance skills (Grades 1-4 on 12/1/21, Grades 5-8 on 12/15/21, and Grades 1-8 on 5/13/22).

All students in Grades 3-8 have the opportunity to sing in an elective choir which meets twice every 7 days.
Choirs perform at music department concerts, worship services, Florida-Georgia District Music Festival, and community field trips.

## HANDBELLS- Ms. Schaffer



Grades 6-8 have the opportunity to play in a handbell choir.
$6^{\text {th }}$ Grade beginning bells meet twice every 7 days.
The $7-8^{\text {th }}$ Grade Falcon Ringers meet three times every 7 days.
Bells perform at music department concerts, worship services, Florida-Georgia District Music
Festival, and community events.

## STUDENT PRAISE BAND -Mr. LeCompte

Praise Band is open to all musicians and singers in Middle School. Rehearsals are held after school once a week to prepare for leading the school chapel worship.

## BAND - Ms. Halverson

All students in Grades 5-8 have the opportunity to play in one of the bands.
There are currently two bands: Beginning Band and Concert Band.
Each band meets during the school day, 3 to 4 days of the 7 letter days.
There are 2 major concerts during the year: Christmas and Spring.
Other performance opportunities include: Chapels, Pep Rallies, Solos, Ensembles, etc.
There is an orientation program prior to the start of school in August.
