We have a **required summer reading** list for $3^{rd} - 8^{th}$ grade students. The language arts teachers will begin the 2021-2022 school year with a class discussion of the novel(s), and an assigned written response will serve as a baseline writing sample for each student.

If your child has already read the designated selection(s), please have him/her read it again. As students learn and grow they read with an expanded knowledge base and gain new insights into literature, and we want the novels to be fresh in their minds to respond appropriately in class.

The list is as follows: students entering **3**rd **grade** are to read either <u>Like Bug Juice on a Burger</u> by Julie Sternberg or <u>Here's Hank: Bookmarks are People Too!</u> by Henry Winkler and Lin Oliver; students entering **4**th **grade** are to read <u>Because of Winn Dixie</u> by Kate DiCamillo; If your child has already read this book, he/she may read <u>Manatee Blues (Vet Volunteers)</u> by Laurie Halse Anderson; students entering **5**th **grade** are to read any book by Andrew Clements (other than Frindle); students entering **6**th **grade** are to read any 2 books by any of the following authors: <u>Carl Hiaasen, Gary</u> <u>Paulsen or Patricia Reilly Giff (except for Pictures of Hollis Woods)</u>; students entering **7**th **grade** are to read <u>The Pigman</u> by Paul Zindel (provided) and <u>Pay it Forward</u> by Catherine Ryan Hyde (Young Reader's Edition - not provided). Students will need to take the AR tests for both on August 18, 2021. 7th and 8th grade have a small supply of books available in the school office.
