## ST. PAUL LUTHERAN SCHOOL PRE-SCHOOL (3) SUPPLY CHECKLIST 2021-2021

Your child will need to bring the following supplies listed below to their Pre-K3 classroom for the 2021-2022 school year. We ask that all supplies and school related items be labeled with their name. Children at this age do not always recognize their belongings.

1 - Full size Backpack to carry papers, projects, and other school items along with lunchbox if lunch is provided from home, both labeled with child's name on the outside.

1 – Outfit with a complete change of UNIFORM clothes (including socks and underwear) in a gallon size Ziploc plastic bag labeled with child's name.

- 2 Boxes of tissues, (preferably the pop up kind)
- 1 Roll of paper towels

2 - Containers of disinfecting wipes (ex: Clorox or Lysol cleaning wipes, not hand sanitizer wipes—for teacher use only)

- 2 Container of baby wipes
- 1 Box of Gallon or Sandwich size Ziploc bags
- 1 4x6 Family photo
- 2-4x6 Baby photos
- 1 Plastic 2-pocket folder
- 1 Plastic school box (pencil box) to store school supplies
- 1 Set of Pipsqueak Crayola markers
- 1 Box of JUMBO Crayola Crayons (8 count)
- 6 Large Glue Sticks
- 1 Bottle of Elmer's glue
- 1 Paint smock (can be a large t-shirt) in a gallon-size Ziploc bag with your child's name on it
- 1 Pair of metal blunt scissors (Fiskars are recommended)
- 1 Reusable water bottle filled each day (will be refilled at water fountains throughout the day)

ALL DAY CHILDREN- Rest items needed: A standard size Crib sheet and small blanket with child's name on it placed in the 2-gallon Ziploc bag provided by your child's teacher.
