- 4th grade Read <u>Because of Winn Dixie</u> by Kate DiCamillo (small supply in office) If your child has already read this book, he/she should read <u>Manatee Blues (Vet Volunteers)</u> by Laurie Halse Anderson
- 5th grade Read any book by Andrew Clements (other than Frindle)
- 6th grade Read Gifted Hands, Revised Kids Edition: The Ben Carson Story (ZonderKidz Biography), then one book by either author: Gary Paulsen or Jennifer A. Nielsen
- 7th grade Read <u>The Westing Game</u> by Ellen Raskin and <u>Walk Two Moons</u> by Sharon Creech
- 8th grade Read <u>The Pigman</u> by Paul Zindel (provided) and <u>The Light in the Forest</u> by Conrad Richter (provided). Students will need to take the AR tests for both on August 18, 2022. 7th and 8th grade have a small supply of books available in the school office.
